


Next Bird Walk ...

It was a sunny morning when a smaller than usual group met for the Spoonbill bird walk and breakfast. The small bush birds were vocal around the car park but water birds on the lake unusually few as we assembled before heading off towards the fire station. We were disappointed to find the Rainbow Bee-eaters, which used congregate on the aerials of the fire station and dart into burrows in the sand at this time of year, were again absent. This has been the case for the last few years and it was speculated that an increase in the frequency and extent of use of the fire station surrounds may be responsible for the birds no longer nesting here.

We welcomed a couple who joined us as visitors for the walk and breakfast and hope to see them again in future when their job as outback tour leaders allows.

Breakfast was as always a wonderful spread and thoroughly enjoyed by all. Thank to Ronda and Graeme for hosting us. Thank you also to Rosanna for the bacon and eggs which unfortunately she was unable to enjoy with us on the day. It is good to hear she is now ok.
