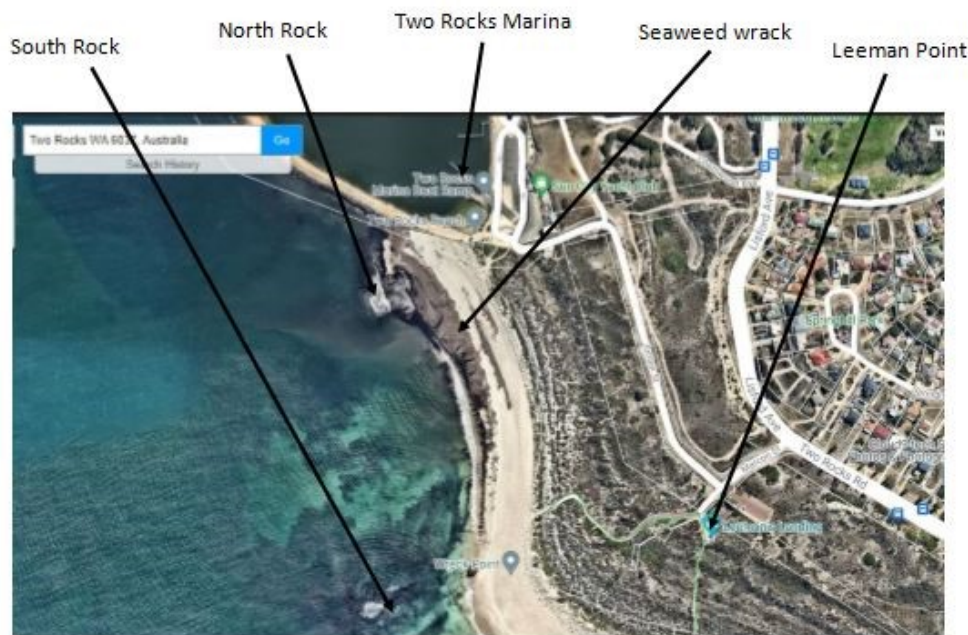

Spoonbill was looking good with the water level being maintained which provided great habitat for 34 birds. A good mix of bush birds and water birds.

A family of Variegated Fairywrens where very inquisitive and came up close and personal at the picnic table. They are not spotted very often so it made for a bit of excitement.

The solitary Great Egret that was present was in breeding plumage and there were both Black Cockatoos present, Carnaby's and Red tails.

It was lovely to see Olive come to birding, we hope that she can make it more often.

The weather forecast for the 12th for our visit to Two rocks is 27 degrees which hopefully, will make the visit a pleasant one.

There are toilet facilities and picnic tables at Leeman's Point .
